

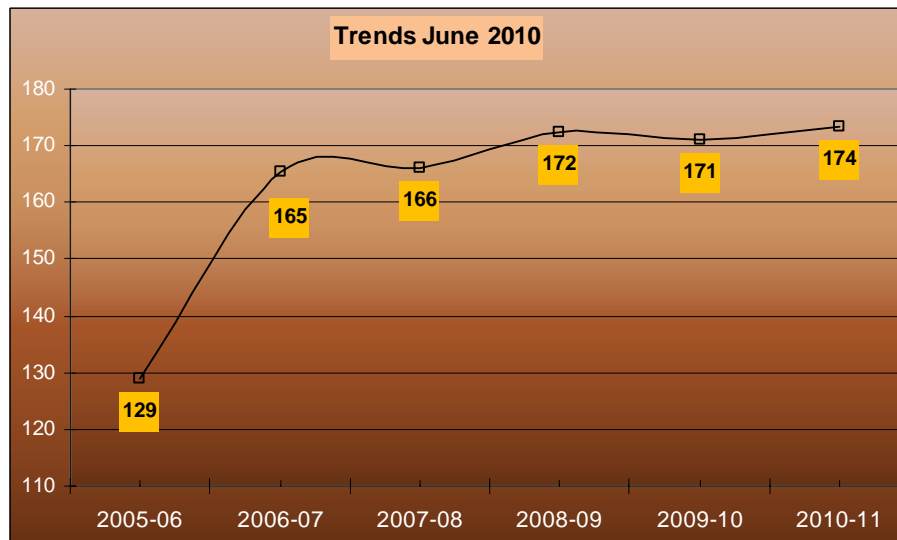


Road Freight Index Chart for June 2010

The RFI stood at 174 Points for the month of June 2010, registering an increase of 3 Point over June 2009.

IRFI Trend for June 2010 :

For Metros Ex – Delhi rates registered highest increase by 10% and Ex - Chennai rates registered highest decrease by 6%.



Automobiles:

The overall production data for April-May 2010 shows production growth of 34% over same period last year with industry producing 2,715,189 vehicles.

Passenger Vehicles segment in April-May 2010 grew at 34% over same period last year. Passenger Cars grew by 35%, Utility Vehicles grew by 30% and Multi Purpose Vehicles grew by 39% in April-May 2010 over April – May2009

For the month of April 2010, three wheelers sales recorded a growth rate of 15%, while Passenger Carriers grew also by 15% and Goods Carriers grew at 14%.

Commercial Vehicles:

The overall sales of Commercial Vehicles segment registered growth at 61% in April-May 2010 as compared to the same period last year. While Medium & Heavy Commercial Vehicles grew at 95% and Light Commercial Vehicles grew at 40%

Forecast for July 2010:

The RFI in July 2009 over July 2008 registered a decrease by 1.33% and 1.29% decrease over June 2008. The RFI stood at 171.06 for the month of July 2009 over 172.35 for the month of June 2008 registering a decrease by 1.29%. The RFI for the month of July 2010 can be expected to decrease marginally.
