

TCI's PAT surges by 52%

New Delhi, May 20 2010: Transport Corporation of India Ltd., India's leading integrated supply chain and logistics solutions provider, announced its annual audited financial results for the fiscal 2009-2010. The full year **Profit After Tax for the Standalone entity** has increased by **51.66% to Rs.42.98 Cr.** from Rs. 28.34 Cr. while the **Net Sales/Income** from Operations during 2009-10 has grown by 11.51% to Rs. 1454.61 Cr. against Rs 1304.42 Cr. **The company's Profit After Tax for the 4th Quarter ended 31 March, 2010, rose by 12% to Rs. 12.53 Cr. from Rs. 11.19 Cr.**

The company's consolidated revenues increased by 12.75% from Rs 1358 Cr to Rs 1531.40 Cr and consolidated PAT was reported at Rs 41.02 Cr.
