



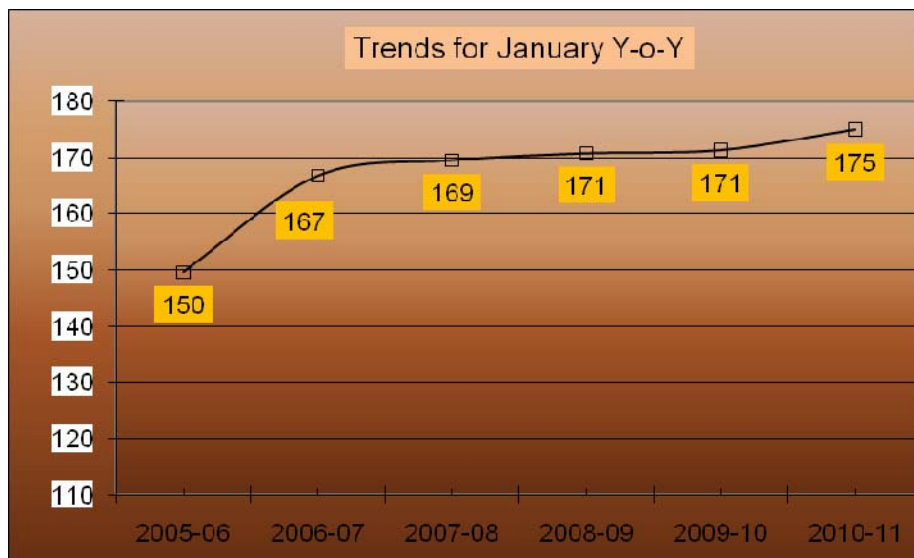
### **Road Freight Index Chart for January 2011**

#### **IRFI Trend for January 2011:**

The RFI stood at 175 Points for the month of January 2011 which was same in the month of December 2010 but it had register an increase by 4 points as compare to December 2009

For Metros Ex – Kolkata rates registered on an average highest increase by 7%, where as Ex – Delhi on an average registered highest decrease by 6%.

#### **Automobiles:**

The overall production data for April- December 2010 shows production growth of 30% over same period last year. In December 2010, production grew at 28% percent over December 2009.

Passenger Vehicles segment in April- December 2010 grew at 32% over same period last year. Passenger Cars grew by 32%, Utility Vehicles grew by 21% and Multi Purpose Vehicles grew by 51% in April- December 2010 over April- December 2009.

For the period of April- December 2010, three wheelers sales recorded a growth rate of 19%, while Passenger Carriers grew also by 22% and Goods Carriers grew at 9%.

**Commercial Vehicles:**

The overall sales of Commercial Vehicles segment registered growth at 34% in April- December 2010 as compared to the same period last year. While Medium & Heavy Commercial Vehicles grew at 43% and Light Commercial Vehicles grew at 27%.

**Forecast for February 2011:**

The RFI in February 2010 over February 2009 had registered an increase of 1% and there is an increase of 1% over January 2010. The RFI stood at 171.59 for the month of February 2010 and 171.30 in the month of January 2010 which registering an increase by 0.29%. The RFI for the month of February 2011 can be expected to increase marginally.
