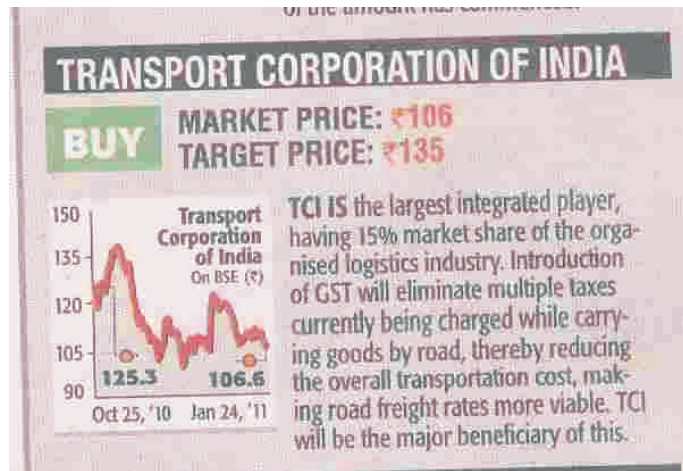

Transport Corporation of India (TCI) registered a net profit of Rs 11.83 crore for the quarter ended December 31, 2010, which is almost at the same level of the Rs 11.81 crore net profit for the third quarter of last fiscal. But the company's operating income registered a growth of 16.5

टीसीआई का राजस्व बढ़ा

नई दिल्ली • ट्रांसपोर्ट कॉर्पोरेशन ऑफ इंडिया (टीसीआई) लिमिटेड के राजस्व में चालू वित्त-वर्ष की तीसरी तिमाही में 16.71 फीसदी बढ़ोतरी दर्ज की गई है। समीक्षाधीन तिमाही में कंपनी का राजस्व 445 करोड़ रुपये रहा, जो पिछले वित्त-वर्ष की समान तिमाही में 381 करोड़ रुपये था। इस दौरान पिछले वित्त-वर्ष की समान तिमाही के 16.63 करोड़ रुपये मुनाफे में 11.32 फीसदी बढ़ोतरी हुई है। समीक्षाधीन तिमाही में कंपनी का मुनाफा बढ़ कर 18.51 करोड़ रुपये पर पहुंच गया है। कंपनी के वाइस चेयरमैन व एमडी डी. पी. अग्रवाल ने बताया कि पूरे वित्त-वर्ष में हम प्रॉफिट मार्जिन में 20-30 फीसदी बढ़ोतरी की उम्मीद कर रहे हैं। (ब्यूरो)
