TCI 25 years on the road

TCI, which went public in 1974, now employs 3,200 people in 760 offices spread over the length and breadth of the country, making it, in terms of the number of offices, the largest transport company in the world. TCI is best defined as a general merchandise carrier with approximately 50 per cent of its freight coming through stray bookings and the balance on contract from various companies.

NOW Like any successful company, TCI has changed itself over the last 30-odd years. Currently it has 100-plus IT-enabled offices with a staff strength of 5,000 people with offices in five countries. From a mere carrier of goods it has transformed itself as an integrated supply chain and logistic solutions provider with a global presence with offices in six countries. It is moving goods valued at 2.5 per cent of the GDP and is now a ₹2,000 crore (income) enterprise generating an annual PAT of ₹52 crore.
